DISCIPLE PEOPLE

Our call to disciple one another, found in Matthew 28:18–20, compels us to invest in each other's lives and to grow together in faith. By teaching and practicing everything Jesus imparted to His disciples, we cultivate an environment where spiritual maturity is nurtured, godly character is shaped, and believers are equipped to continue Christ's mission. In doing so, we sustain a legacy of Christ-centered growth that endures for generations.



WHAT WE BELIEVE IN

01 God The Father (YHWH)

We believe there is only one true and living God, who is immutable and infinite in His essence. He is not only a reality—He is the Ultimate Reality, an intelligent Spirit, and the Creator of all. He exists as God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit.

02 Jesus (Yeshua)

We believe Jesus is the Savior, the Lord Christ, and the incarnate expression of God's love for humanity. He embodies grace, being fully God and fully man. He died on the cross to redeem God's creation, and He rose on the third day with all power in heaven and on earth in His hands.

03 Holy Spirit (Ruach Ha-Kodesh)

We believe in the Holy Spirit, the Comforter sent by God. The Holy Spirit empowers believers, illuminates God's Word, and reassures us that God is ever-present. He convicts us of sin, guides us into truth, and leads us toward righteousness.

04 The Church

We believe the Church is Christ's bride and His body, a witness to the world through word and sacrament. It is a fellowship of regenerated men and women called out to live together in community, reflecting God's love and truth.

05 Scripture

We believe the Scriptures are God's written authority for the Church. Inspired by the Holy Spirit, they were given to ordinary men and women. They are inerrant in principle, infallible in content, and serve as our ultimate guide in faith and practice.

06 The Virgin Birth

We believe that Jesus was conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary. Without sin, He is unique, as no other man ever has been or ever will be. He is both the Son of God and God the Son.

07 Humanity

We believe humans were created in the image of God, who breathed life into them. By their own choice, humans rebelled against God, losing their state of protection and becoming separated from Him. As a result, all are sinners in need of redemption. Through Jesus Christ—the only hope for reconciliation—humans can once again experience God's peace.

08 Baptism & Holy Communion

We believe that baptism is an outward demonstration of God's inward renewal of life in the believer. Through baptism, in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, we publicly identify with Christ's death, burial, and resurrection, entering under God's authority and protection. Baptism precedes participation in the Lord's Supper (Holy Communion), established by Jesus through the bread and the cup. The Lord's Table is open to all who share faith in Him, symbolizing continued fellowship with Christ and His Church.

09 Justification

We believe that justification brings us into right relationship with God, accomplished apart from any good works on our part. It is the pardoning of sin and the granting of eternal life through the redemptive blood of Jesus Christ, demonstrating God's immense love for humanity.

10 Salvation

We believe in God's saving grace. Salvation is offered freely to all through the Gospel. Acceptance requires thankful, penitent, and obedient faith. Nothing prevents a sinner from being saved except their own refusal to believe. Disbelief and rejection of God lead to one's own condemnation.
